



IF A FIRE BREAKS OUT IN YOUR HOME

- ✓ IMMEDIATELY LEAVE THE ROOM WHERE YOU FOUND THE FIRE AND CLOSE THE DOOR TO THE ROOM BEHIND YOU
- ✓ TELL EVERYONE IN YOUR HOME, GET THEM TO LEAVE AND CLOSE THE ENTRANCE DOOR OF YOUR FLAT BEHIND YOU
- ✓ DO NOT STAY BEHIND OR ATTEMPT TO PUT THE FIRE OUT
- ✓ LEAVE THE BUILDING BY THE NEAREST SAFE EXIT AND NOTIFY THE FIRE BRIGADE (CALL 999 or 112)

IF YOU SEE OR HEAR OF A FIRE IN ANOTHER PART OF THE BUILDING

- ✓ THE BUILDING IS DESIGNED TO CONTAIN A FIRE IN THE FLAT WHERE IT STARTS. THIS MEANS IT WILL USUALLY BE SAFE TO STAY IN YOUR OWN FLAT IF THE FIRE IS ELSEWHERE
- ✓ REMAIN IN THE NEAREST ROOM WITH THE DOOR CLOSED
- ✓ YOU MUST LEAVE IMMEDIATELY IF SMOKE OR HEAT AFFECTS YOUR
 HOME OR IF YOU ARE TOLD TO LEAVE BY THE FIRE SERVICE
- ✓ IF YOU ARE IN ANY DOUBT, LEAVE THE BUILDING

CALL THE FIRE SERVICE

✓ DIAL 999 or 112 ASK FOR THE FIRE BRIGADE – SAY WHERE YOU ARE

DO NOT TAKE RISKS

DO NOT STOP TO COLLECT BELONGINGS

DO NOT HEAD IN THE DIRECTION OF THE FIRE

DO NOT ATTEMPT TO PUT OUT THE FIRE

DO NOT RETURN TO YOUR HOME UNTIL YOU ARE INFORMED BY THE

FIRE OFFICER THAT IT IS SAFE TO DO SO
