## **Natural History**

The underlying magnesium limestone, heavy clay sub-soils and the thin soil cover on the former colliery spoil heap, provide a wide range of habitats and a rich diversity of flora and fauna.

Please help to conserve this natural haven by observing the following advice:

- During the bird nesting season (March-September), please keep all dogs on a lead near any long grass to avoid disturbing ground-nesting species
- Admire and photograph the wildflowers but do not pick them; leave them for others to enjoy
- No fishing (except for Brierley Pond project members). Fishing day tickets are available at the visitor centre
- No motorbikes or quad bikes
- Take your litter home
- · Keep your dog under control
- Have consideration for other park users
- No camping, fires or barbeques
- Keep out of the water. No dogs allowed in the lake and ponds.



## How to find us...

There are brown tourist information signs directing visitors to the park from the A38. The main car park and visitor centre are accessed via Skegby Road, Huthwaite, Sutton in Ashfield, NG17 2PL.

There are regular bus services along Sutton Road, Huthwaite serving the main entrance and along Stoneyford Road, Stanton Hill.

The nearest train station is Sutton Parkway station on the Robin Hood line, 3.5 miles away.
